The Instant "Off" Switch

Misplaced your debit card? Don't panic. You can flip your card "off" instantly while you search the house or car, and flip it back "on" the second you find it.

If your card is truly lost or stolen, contact ServU directly to permanently block it and order your replacement.

Custom Real-Time Alerts

Knowledge is power. Set up immediate email or push notifications for specific activities—like transactions over a certain dollar amount, international charges, or online purchases. If your card is used, you'll be notified right away.

Tailored Spending Controls

Take charge of your budget or guard against unauthorized use by limiting card activity. You can restrict spending by dollar amounts, transaction types (like blocking ATM cash withdrawals), or even specific merchant categories (such as travel, hotels, or entertainment).

Nominations may be made by petition by contacting Lauran Wilson, at 607-936-2293. Petitions must be received no later than 5:00pm on August 14, 2026 and should be returned to: ServU Federal Credit Union c/o Lauran Wilson, 87 Victory Highway, Painted Post, NY 14870. Positions on the ballot will be decided by a draw of lots on August 19, 2026 and nominees will be posted at the Painted Post office. If an election is necessary, ballots will be mailed to all credit union members, age 16 and older, no later than August 24, 2026. Ballots must be returned to the Credit Union by midnight on September 18, 2026. Results of the election will be announced at the credit union's annual meeting on September 23, 2026 at 7:00pm, at the Painted Post office, 87 Victory Highway, Painted Post, New York. Nominations from the floor are not accepted. All directors serve without pay. Members who are interested in becoming involved are encouraged to seek positions on credit union committees prior to serving on the board.
